## Terms and conditions of participation in the conference

### Participation form:

- 1. Distance (abstracts and articles publication in a Book of the scientific papers, as well as presentations).
- 2. Online, using ZOOM Web-platform (the link will be sent on the participants' emails and will be published on the College web page <a href="https://college.nuph.edu.ua">https://college.nuph.edu.ua</a>.).

To participate in the conference, it is necessary to fill out the registration form and add materials for publication by *March 1*, *2024* (*article* (3-6 pages) or *abstract* (1-2 pages) in electronic format saved as .doc file; the name of the file is the author's last name (e.g. *Ivanenko.doc*); or *presentation* as .pdf format) using the link *https://forms.gle/CuYdtucYyat8eJTv8* 

During the conference, it is possible to comment and discuss current issues. The electronic version of the Book of abstracts can be downloaded from the site.

Certificates will be sent to the conference participants by e-mail.

## Participation is free.

## Presentation requirements:

Presentation can be up to 10 minutes.

Presentation must be visualized using Microsoft PowerPoint or its analogues. The front page of the presentation should contain title, name of the speaker, name of the supervisor, name of the educational institution.

# Technical requirements guide for article or abstract

- 1. The conference working languages are *Ukrainian* and *English*.
- 2. The number of authors of one publication is *no more than three*.
- 3. Theses must not have been published before.
- 4. A4 sheet format, text editor MS Word (extensions doc, docx). Portrait page orientation (vertically). Line spacing 1.5 pt; paragraph 1.25 cm. All fields 2 cm. 14 pt Times New Roman font. Page numbering is not necessary. Use MS Equation 3.0 for drawing chemical structures. Graphic materials should be grouped and embedded in the text. No scanning. Text alignment, transfers, and formatting should be done using the program functions.
- 5. Preparation of materials:
  - UDC is placed on the front page at the left top;
  - the title is written in the middle of the page in capital letters in bold;
  - author's first and last name a new line in ordinary letters in bold;

- educational institution a new line in ordinary letters in bold;
- city, country a new line in ordinary letters in bold.
- 6. Illustrative material should be highlighted in italics without quotes, references to it should be in round brackets. Only quotation marks should be used. The word "Table" and its number should be placed on the right (printed in bold), and its title in the center (bold). Please don't put more than 2 tables, diagrams, or figures.
- 7. Use square brackets for references to the citation source, e.g.: [5, p. 141].
- 8. The list of information data (no more than 5 names) must be completed in accordance with the State Standards of Ukraine 8302:2015 requirements «Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General requirements and composition rules». The list should be in alphabetical order.
- 9. Materials are published in the author's edition. The author is responsible for the accuracy of facts, statistics, and other information. The Editorial Board reserves the right to review, edit, shorten, and reject abstracts or articles.
- 10. Materials that do not meet the requirements will be rejected.

Please adhere to the principles of academic integrity when writing the articles and abstracts.
